
- ☐ January 2007: The fate of TWI...will it fly?

- ☐ March 2007: Two Way Immersion is approved by the board of education!
- ☐ April 2007: Two Way Immersion at Bijou is ready to go!

Where it all started... 2006-2007 school year

In the summer of 2006, parents from around the community sent a letter to LTUSD asking to explore the possibility of a Two Way Immersion Program at Bijou Community School. With lots of hard work, research, visits to other schools, monetary donations, and commitment from the 20+ students and their families, an amazing teacher (Maestra Shaina), and a supportive administration and other staff at Bijou, by the Fall of 2007, we had our first kindergarten class...20 students who are now 2020 graduates! 
### TWI First (2008-2009) & Second Grade (2009-2010)

As our 2020 graduates finished 1st grade, the Two Way Immersion expanded. The success our TWI students had in learning English and Spanish in kinder and first, made headlines, and more families wanted to join!

So, parents campaigned again, and the LTUSD school board voted, and two kinder class became two... now 44 students were being educated in English and Spanish!!!
